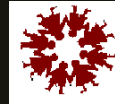

VEGETABLE PRINTING

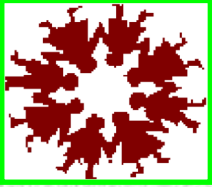

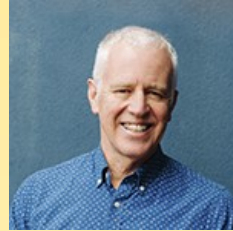
