Ditto (from GV CASA education program) taught us about personal safety and how we can recognise good and bad feelings.



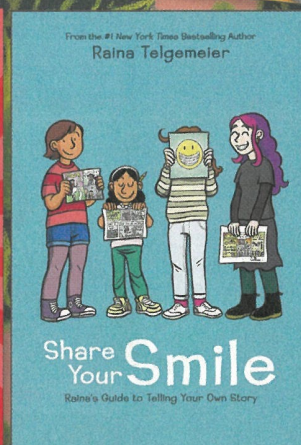
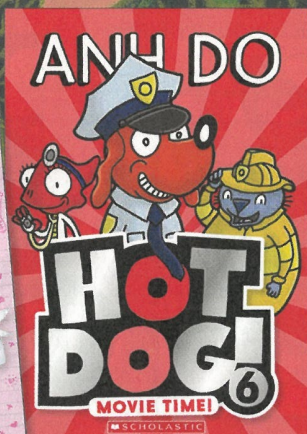
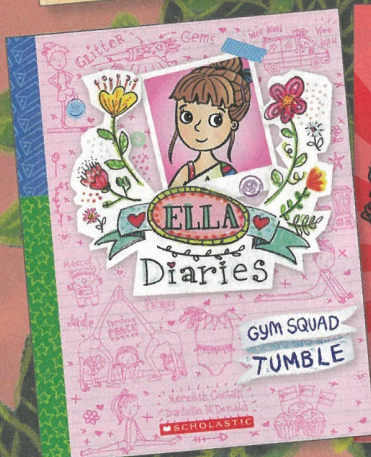
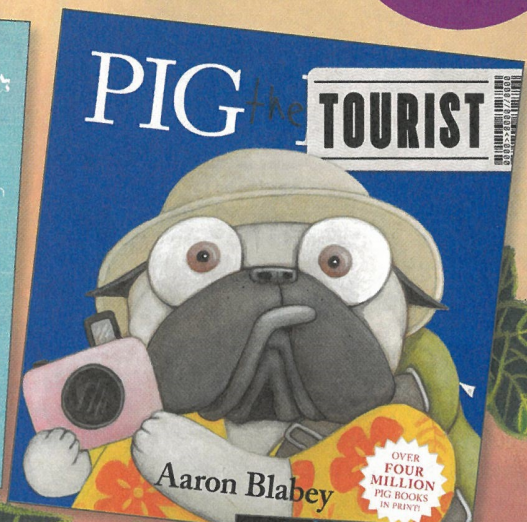
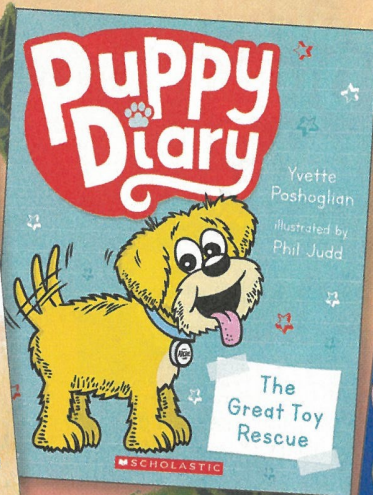
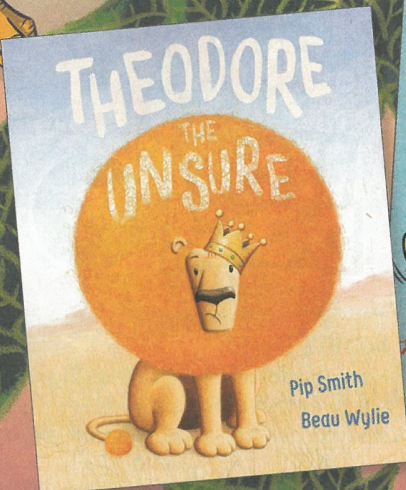
