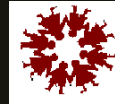

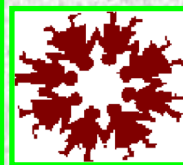

Language of independence building CONFIDENCE

INTRODUCTION

Families always develop shared language around the values that have strong meaning for them. If independence and self-sufficiency are important then it will be reflected in your family's proprietary language.

In fact, it's through shared language that culture exists. If you are looking to building a culture of independence in your family (or in your classroom) then creating your proprietary language around independence is a great way to start. The following twelve examples of independence-building language and principles behind them that will help you create your own family's language.

SWIMMING FUN DAY



On Friday 1st March we will be having swimming races at the Stanhope pool. Starting time will be confirmed next week. Students are able to come to school dressed in their house colours. **McEwen house is orange and Winter house is aqua.**

If your child is new to the school, what house they are in, will be written on the front page of the newsletter. Students are the school's responsibility until 3:15, so if you are intending of collecting them from the pool before this time, you need to fill in an early collection form, which is a requirement from the Department Of Education.

Please be at the pool by 3:00 to collect, otherwise they will be taken back to school.

Students are able to bring money to spend in the kiosk, but this will be directed by teachers and it is the child's responsibility to take care of their own money. Students need recess snacks, lunch (which will be eaten at school beforehand) and a drink bottle. We are a Sunsmart school, so all students need a rashie or t-shirt to wear in the pool, and also wear a hat at all other times.
