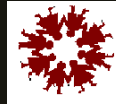

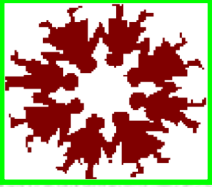
Bush Dance

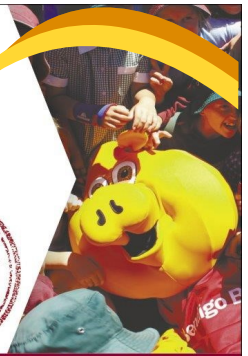
