### Parent Opinion Survey

## Reports

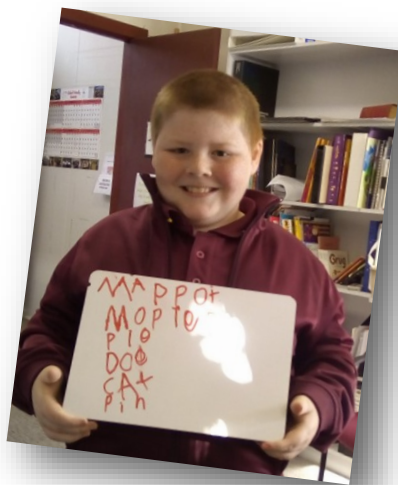
Semester One reports will be available for collection from the office from **Thursday 28th June**. Please advise us if you would prefer your child's report to be mailed out instead of collected from the office.

Grade 3-6 students will be receiving access information to the Department's online resources and applications, through a secure network. Students will then have their own unique password and access code. At this point it is very important that they keep that information secure and are responsible for managing that security. Positive relationships also increase a child's sense of social connectedness and belonging, which can result in better health and academic outcomes.

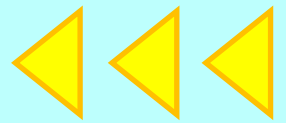


## TERM 3 UPDATES
