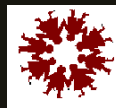
Condolences

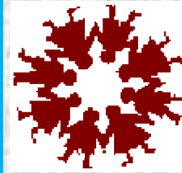

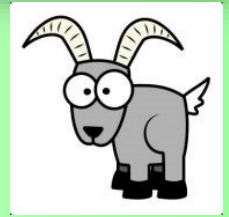
