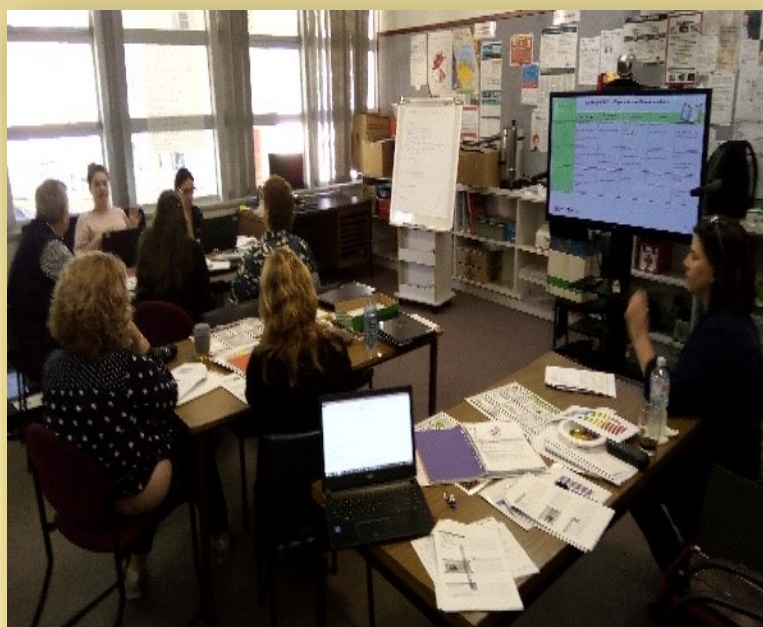

Lots of eating and running and lots of fun for our prep ones, and two's on Monday night! These photos are just a sample of the evening's activities.



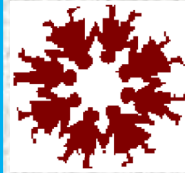

Michael - How can we make peoples lives easier?

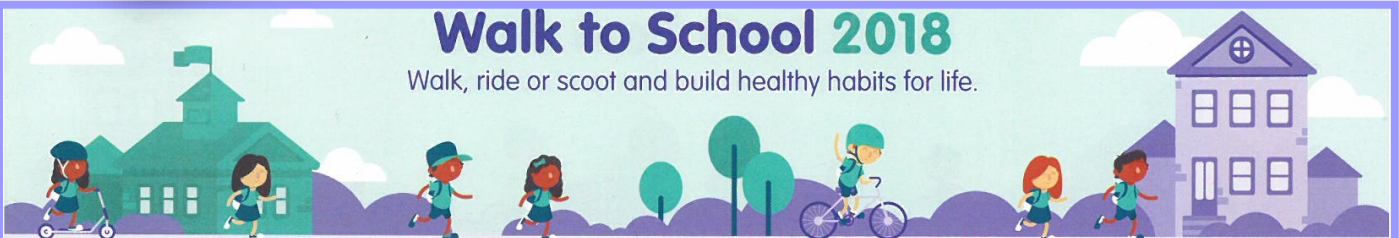
Jim - How can you take your ball handling skills to the next level?
