Christine Owen will be back at the helm next term. I wish her, the students, staff and families a fantastic fourth term and beyond.



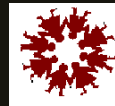
End of term

CLASSROOM LIBRARIES

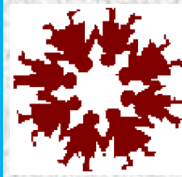
