Swimming & Water Awareness Program

Our whole school Swimming & Water Awareness Program begins on Monday. Attached to the newsletter are permission forms for student to participate in this valuable program.

Prep parents who would like their students to attend this program on Wednesdays, are welcome to bring them to the pool, ready for a 12.45pm lesson start.

A reminder that ALL students will need to be able to dress and undress themselves independently for this program.

The only cost for this program is the pool entry of **\$4.20 per student, per day OR a Family Pass**. Please let the school know if you have a Family Pass by Monday. All cash money sent with students MUST be in a sealed bag/envelope with STUDENT NAME & AMOUNT clearly printed on the outside. Correct money only please. We do not have change. All money is to be given to the classroom teacher no later than 9.00am each day. Please do not bring money to the pool.

Attached to this newsletter are permission forms which **must** be signed and returned by **Monday** so that students can participate. Permission can alternatively be given immediately via our school management system, uEducateUs. Information about uEducateUs is found further on in the newsletter. Please note that it is a **'no pay, no swim'** program at the pool.

uEducateUs

Our school uses uEducateUs as a primary means for attendance records, student reporting and a number of other aspects of school life. Families are invited to access the 'family' component so permissions can be granted easily and quickly, absence notifications can be sent and student reports received securely. Attached to this newsletter are individual letters containing your confidential login details. These are for new families and current families who are not currently identified as 'active'. These must not be shared with anyone, to avoid compromising the security of your access to your child or children. 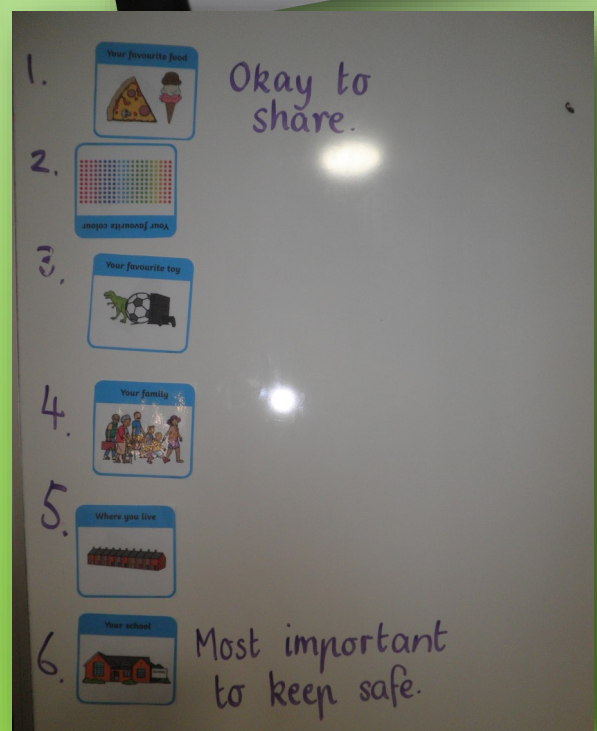
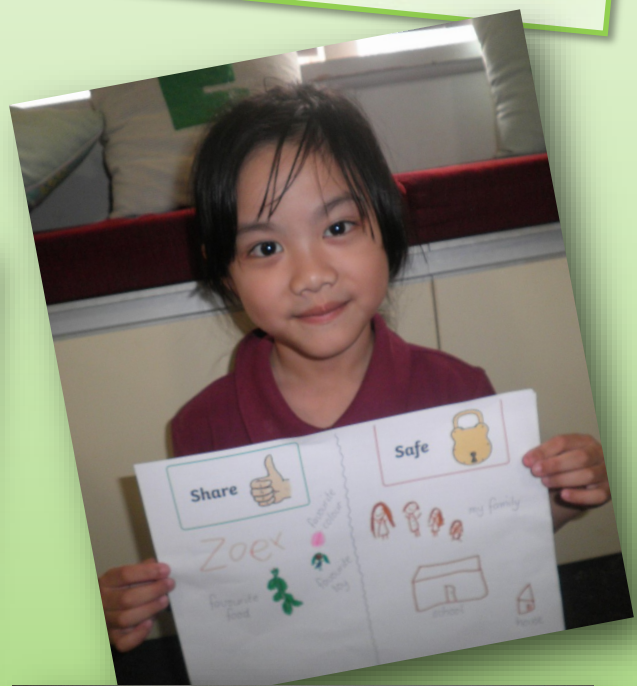

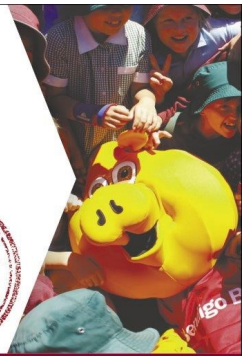
