From the Principal

Information Overload!

This week there are a **lot** of attachments to the newsletter. Please make sure you carefully read through them <u>all</u>, as they are important documents regarding your child's activities at school. Some documents require your signature to confirm that you have read through it and others ask you for specific **permissions** which you may or may not choose to give.

There are quite a lot of documents regarding the use of digital devices by students at school. Yesterday grade 3-6 went through the Acceptable Use Agreement with me to ensure they understand their obligations when using laptops and other devices in the classroom.

Please read this through with your child and **return the slip** at the end of the Agreement by the 6th of March . <u>Please</u> keep the document for your reference.

There is also a specifications sheet for those from grade 4 and above, who may wish to purchase their own laptop (BYOD). This is invitational and NOT compulsory.

Our school will be using Microsoft Office 365 for classroom purposes. There is an information sheet enclosed. This also has an OPT OUT box to sign and return, but <u>ONLY</u> if you <u>DO NOT WANT</u> your child accessing Office 365. If you are happy with your child using laptops and hence Office 365, then you just keep the information sheet.

Swimming and Water Awareness Program

This starts on the 17th February and will run for two weeks. Please make sure your child has independent dressing and undressing skills prior to the program as no parents or teachers will be permitted in the change rooms whilst there are students in the change rooms. Students must be able to get into their bathers in time to start their lesson and get dry and dressed again afterwards to return to school <u>in a timely</u> manner.

It's also a good idea to have a waterproof bag for wet bathers and towels.

Students will be attending the pool in two main groups, so there will be one group at the pool at the end of the school day. You will be advised of collection details in next week's newsletter.
