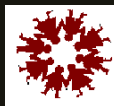

Social Media Use

Recently I included information about the safe and respectful use of social media by families and students. Everyone should be very aware and careful of what they post and about whom. Using someone's image, writing, messages and sharing them without permission could lead to not only a breach of trust, but could potentially have legal consequences. Such ill-advised sharing and posting on social media, soon becomes gossip for others far removed from the original intended audience. The impact on the school students and community can be destructive and very damaging.

I remind families of our values of Learning, Success, Citizenship and Respect. The latter two values are very important when using social media. Our school also has a Code of Conduct to encourage staff and students to model positive and respectful behaviour.

If there are issues or concerns:

- ◆ we have a Complaints Policy which outlines the processes and procedures we have in place to address and manage complaints and concerns.
- ◆ There are also posters around the school identifying how and who to contact with issues and concerns.
- ◆ We also have several communication tools available in addition to personal contact, through uEducateUs, Class Dojo, SMS, phone and email, which we encourage you to pursue, rather than take to social media.
