# From the Principal

## Class Dojo is Rocking!

Well done to the grade 3-6 class who are showing up each morning, ready to learn. And of course, meet their classmates on WebEx! Most students are completing their set tasks and getting them handed in on time. I hope families are enjoying the Friday Family fun Days. These are designed to provide some de-stressing to families and students, because not all learning happens at school. Prep, ones and two's, you have a little way to go to match the attendance numbers during morning check-ins. Don't let the big kids outshine you! Make sure you keep a regular school routine whenever you can, so that your learning doesn't suffer. Make sure you keep up to date with all your learning tasks!

## Things you (students) need to do:

- ◆ Make sure you complete as many of your tasks as possible each day.
- ◆ If you miss a task, make sure you catch it up the next day.
- ◆ If you get stuck, send a message to the teacher on Class Dojo and go onto the next task until your teacher replies to you.
- ◆ Do your best work – NOT your quickest. Teachers are looking at the quality of your work.
- ◆ Make sure you take clear photos, the right way up and with text or drawings that can be easily seen.
- ◆ Other teachers, like Mr Pettigrew, Mr Bragge and Mrs Owen, will also be putting up tasks to complete. They may not look like those of Mrs Sheedy or Mrs Feldtmann, but they still need to be done!

## School Breakfast Club

We have had our Breakfast Club foods delivered to school. **Families will be able to come and collect their allocation from the school from tomorrow onwards.** One pack per student. Normally, this would all be happening at school, but this is the fairest way we can work out to make sure kids are able to access healthy food 'at school' when you are remote learning.

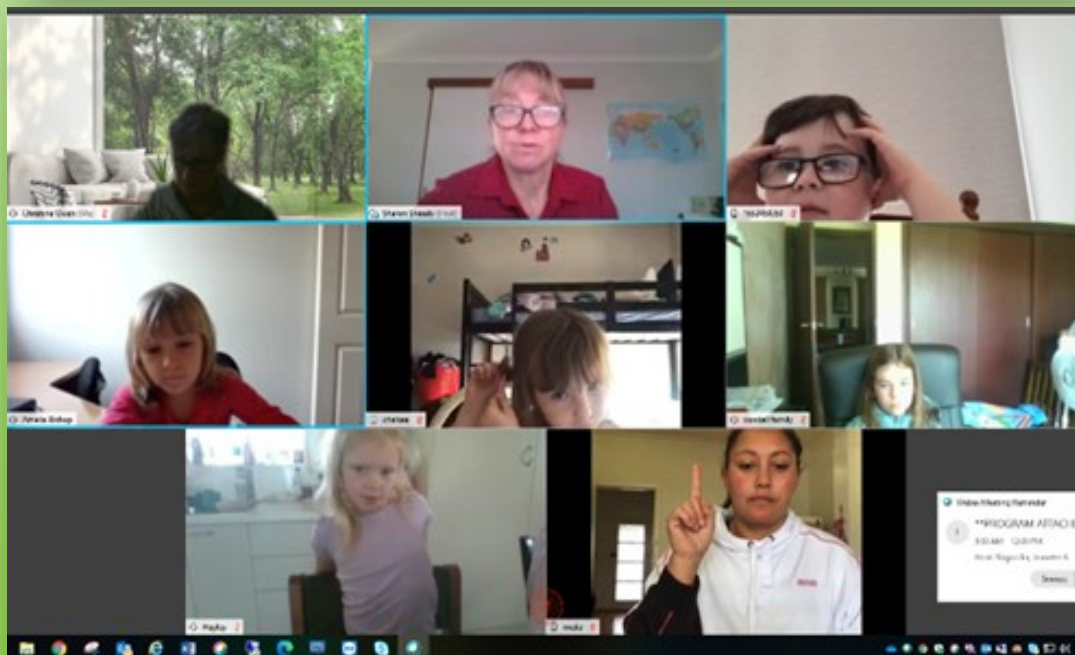

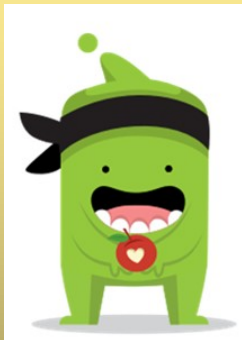

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
