# From the Principal

## Second Last Week of Term 3!

Yet another term is coming to a close and we are still in remote learning. Most students have been fantastic and completed the daily tasks that their teachers have set. Some, however, have still got a lot of work to complete and should really get cracking on getting this work done. This is important learning and will be needed as we head into term 4 and on to 2021.

Students' effort and the quantity / quality of the work returned this term will also be reflected in end of year reports!

## Term 4

There have been a lot of rumours and misinformation going around about what is and isn't happening. What is happening is that week one of term 4 will be **remote learning**, **NOT** an extra week of holidays. Your teachers will be organising individual students to come on site for some discussions and assessments of school work. This will only take about half an hour. Details about who and when to come in will be sent out to families via uEducateUs in the next couple of weeks.

**Week 2** of term 4, is when **ALL** students return to onsite learning, that is on **Monday 12<sup>th</sup> October**, all students are expected to be back on-site. Bring **ALL** the workbooks, handouts, booklets etc that you took home, with you, back to school on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> October.

Remember too, that you will need to bring your hats as part of being Sun Smart and safe.

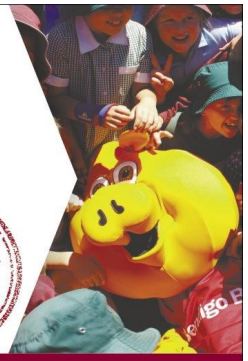
