Safety First!

One of the ways we work to protect students is to teach them procedures of what to do in an emergency. This week all students practiced an emergency lock down, should there be an incident whilst students were outside in the playground or playing sports. Students were given opportunities to practice before the 'real' drill. Each term we practice a different type of emergency response, so that students and staff know exactly what to do and where to go, in the event of an emergency incident.

Parent – Teacher Conferences

Online scheduling has now closed to book a time to see your child's teacher. Teachers have allocated times to those who have not already booked a time. This information has now been sent out via Class Dojo.

Ride To School Day

Families have now been messaged on Class Dojo that tomorrow is national Ride to School Day. Students will be able to ride their bikes or scooters around at recess, following specific guidelines and pathways. All students **MUST** have a legal bicycle helmet, conforming with the Australian Standards, AS/NZS 2063. This also applies to students riding scooters.

Motor bike helmets, horse riding helmets or any other helmets are NOT acceptable and students will not be allowed to ride within the school grounds at recess or lunchtime. Bicycles and scooters MUST also have functioning brakes and be in good working order. Students will only be allowed to ride their own bikes or scooters.

Personal Items from Home

Staff have observed quite a lot of items being brought to school from home. These items might include toys and special belongings. Our school will not take any responsibility for any damage or loss to such items. These items should remain in students bags and not be placed on desks or tables where students are working as they cause unnecessary distraction from their learning. Jewellery is not part of school uniform and should not be worn to school. Please see our website for the complete Uniform Policy.



MEATLOAF


Serves 6

- mix (from a packet)

- sprinkle of salt and pepper 2 tablespoons tomato




Mix it, stirring very well until it is mixed and smooth.








Turn oven to 180°C (350°F) Put mince in a big bowl.




With clean hands, shape it firmly into a loaf.
