The Shire of Campaspe is advertising for a School Crossing Supervisor for our school crossing. It will be on the Shire of Campaspe website on Friday.

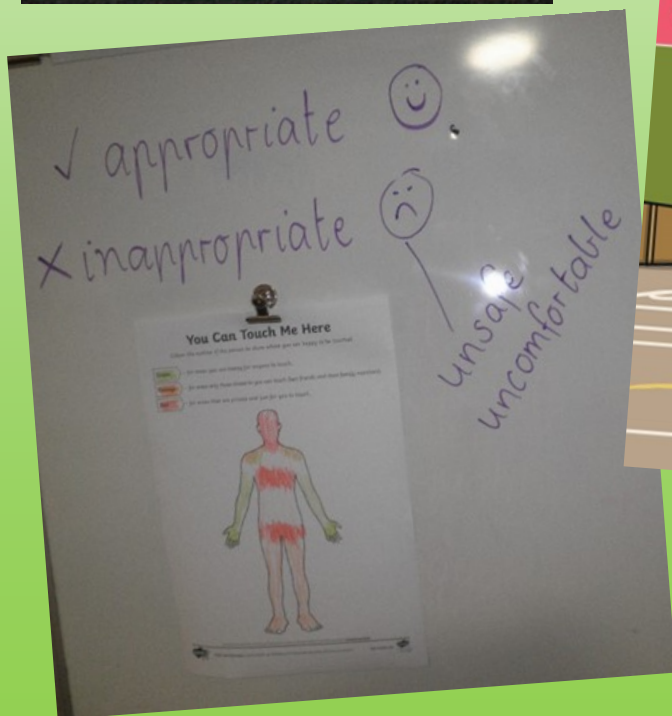

In our Respectful Relationships (Health) program this week we focused on appropriate and inappropriate ways of touching each other at school. It was discussed how our behaviour can make others feel unsafe and uncomfortable.

We talked about the areas of our bodies which are green zones (acceptable for anyone to touch), orange zones (only acceptable for family and close friends to touch) and red zones (private for only self to touch).

While viewing a power-point we discussed how hugging and kissing (and physical aggression) were not appropriate ways to touch each other. A poster is displayed, about ways we can greet adults and our friends at school.
