# **From the Principal**

#### Acting Principal

It is with pleasure that I can announce that Mr Tom Mangan will be in the role of Acting Principal while I take leave to undergo some necessary surgery. Mr Mangan was the successful applicant and has all the necessary skills and qualifications for this position. Mr Mangan will be in the role until the end of term. He comes to us from Kyabram P-12 where he is a Leading Teacher and has a 5-6 class. I know everyone will make Mr Mangan very welcome.

#### Wellbeing

Staff have noticed some behavioural changes in students over the last few months. Our students' resilience is very low, overall and many are unable to manage their emotions well when presented with situations outside their control, which can manifest in different behaviours. This is not confined to our school. Other schools across the state report the same sorts of behaviours. The on again off again nature of COVID-based restrictions and lockdowns is not helping students to maintain their emotional balance, so it is very important that the school and families make every effort to provide that support and guidance that will get kids through challenging times. It may be personality clashes, schoolwork, routine changes and any of these sorts of things can present challenges and it is critical to students' growth that they are given the strategies to manage different situations. In the next week or so, we are hopeful of having a wellbeing staff member join us to assist with supporting and guiding students to be resilient and capable young people.

#### <u>Talk To Us</u>

We have become aware of some discontent among the parent community. While such conversations continue out in the community, it only hinders the progress and stability of the school. If you have any issues you'd like discussed or addressed, please let your teacher know, myself or Mr Tom Mangan. We are always happy to understand your concerns and work out ways to address them. But we can't fix what we aren't told about. Please come and talk to us.

#### **3-6 Athletics**

The grade 3-6 class participated in the Kyabram Athletics event, today. This was a great chance for students to be involved in a range of sporting activities with other students. It was also a great opportunity for students to just have fun with other children, and forget about the wider world problems for a little while. They have been practicing at school to achieve their 'PB' in several events.


# **Out of Hours School Care**


