VISITORS AND VOLUNTEERS

Vaccination requirements for visitors and volunteers performing work in schools have been recently updated.

Visitors and volunteers performing work on school sites (both inside and outdoors) must have had at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine and must have had two doses of COVID-19 vaccine by 29 November 2021 or have a valid medical exception. Before visitors and volunteers enter a school building you must now:

- Check in with the QR code.
- Wear a face mask.
- Be free of COVID-19 symptoms.
- Provide evidence of their vaccination status to be recorded at school.
- Adhere to COVID Safety requirements.

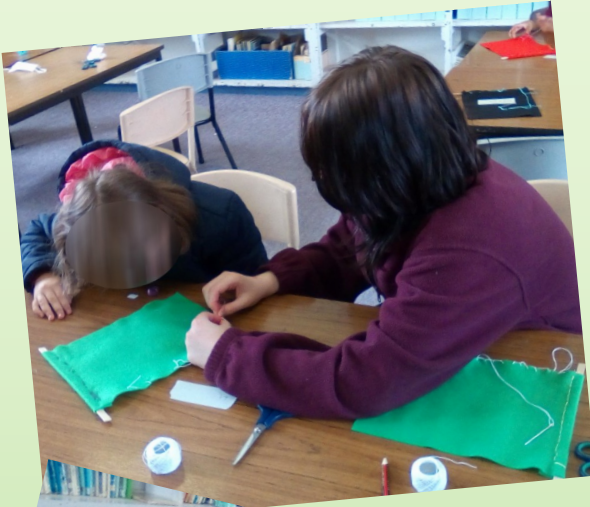
