VISITORS AND VOLUNTEERS

Vaccination requirements for visitors and volunteers performing work in schools have been recently updated.

Visitors and volunteers performing work on school sites (both inside and outdoors) MUST be double vaccinated and show proof of vaccination either via the Vic Services App or an issued certificate.

Before visitors and volunteers enter a school building they must:

- ◆ Check in with QR code.
- ◆ Wear a face mask.
- ◆ Be free of COVID-19 symptoms.
- ◆ Provide evidence of their vaccination status to be recorded at school.
- ◆ Adhere to COVID Safety requirements.

Transport

We will provide buses to and from camps from central pick up points in Melbourne, Ballarat and Bendigo or families can drop off or pick up their child from camp.

Cost

The all-inclusive cost for a five-day camp is \$45. This includes all meals, accommodation, and program activities. However, we can reduce or waive the fees where even this low charge would cause financial difficulties for a child's family.
