

Dear parents and carers,

I'm writing to let you know that a person/people with COVID-19 was on our school site while infectious.

Date positive case/s reported:	Tuesday 8 th March, 2022
Impacted class/es or year level/s	Any extracurricular activities, including school bus transport
P-6 students	Water Safety & Swimming Program

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

If your child is not experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, they can continue to attend school, but you should monitor for symptoms.

Students who show symptoms of COVID-19 cannot attend school and should get tested immediately and isolate until they receive a negative result.

Students should continue with twice-a-week rapid antigen testing (RAT) on school days.

Students should continue with daily rapid antigen testing (RAT) on school days (5 days per week).

Students who have recovered from COVID-19 do not need to participate in screening testing for 30 days after their isolation period has ended.

If your child returns a positive RAT result and has symptoms and/or has been in contact with someone with COVID-19, it is very likely that your child has COVID-19.

- You must advise the school and the Department of Health about the positive result
- Your child must stay home for 7 days, and then only leave home once they feel well
- Everyone in your household is a close contact and must isolate for 7 days.

If your child tests positive with a RAT but does not have symptoms and don't believe they have been in contact with anyone with COVID-19 it is recommended getting a PCR test within the first 48 hours of testing positive and stay isolated at all times until they receive their result.

If your child's subsequent PCR test is negative, they will be able to leave isolation and return to school. If the PCR test result is positive, they must follow the steps above.

Reporting your child's positive test

If your child tests positive to COVID-19 you need to report the positive case through the <u>Student COVID-19</u> <u>Test Portal</u> or you can notify the school in writing or by phone.

You must also report your child's positive test to the Department of Health via the <u>COVID-19 Positive Rapid</u> <u>Antigen Test Self-Reporting Form</u> or call centre on 1800 675 398.
