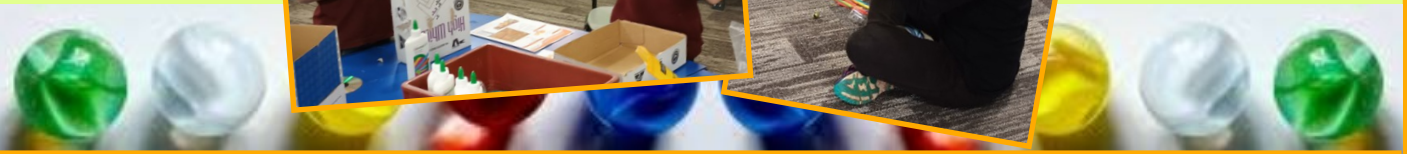
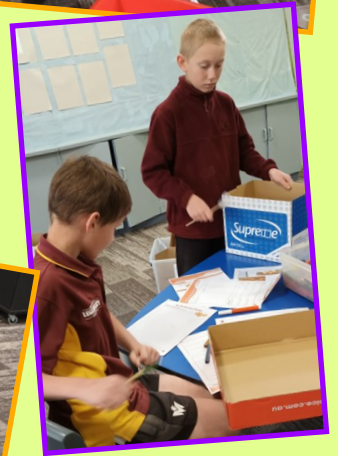
# Wonderful Wednesdays

## **4. Invite your child to do other things**
