From the Principal

Devastation

By now there won't be a single person in Australia that isn't aware of the catastrophic impact of the flooding across the eastern States of Australia. Many schools are closed due to the need to ensure the safety of students and staff who live in impacted areas. We have been very fortunate not to have had to close our school and return to remote learning.

Over the weekend, I worked with Regional staff to keep them updated on our situation and maintained communication with families as situations changed, sometimes very rapidly. It will be important for families to continue to monitor Class Dojo for any updates following the expected rains over the next few days.

Assessment and Reporting

Over the next few weeks, students will be assessed in key learning areas and reports written based on those assessments, together with previous in-class assessments and tests, and classwork evidence. Reports will be ready for publication in the final week of term via uEducateUs.

Soccer Clinic

Sadly, the arranged Soccer clinic which was to take place on Tuesday morning, was another victim of the flooding. The clinic has been re-scheduled until 8th November. All was not lost, however! Ms Whitney came to the rescue and students were given some training in soccer skills and the opportunity to participate in a modified game.


