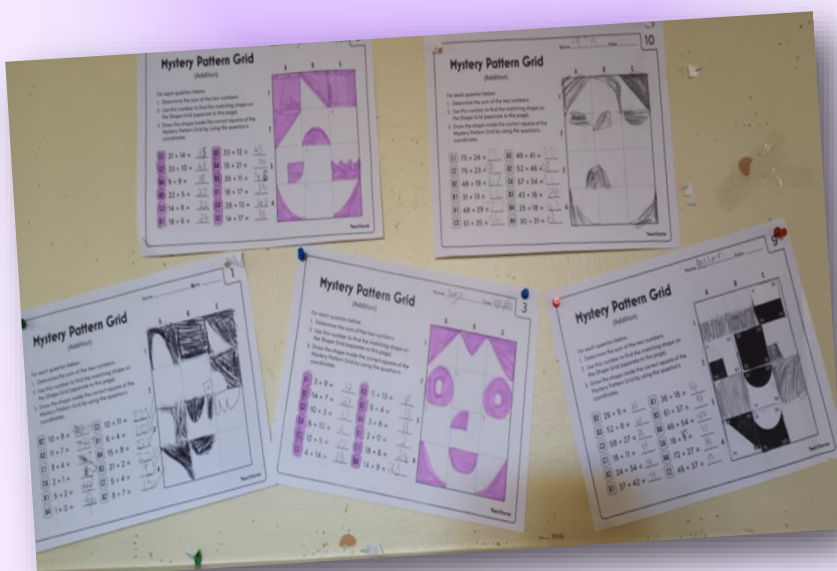

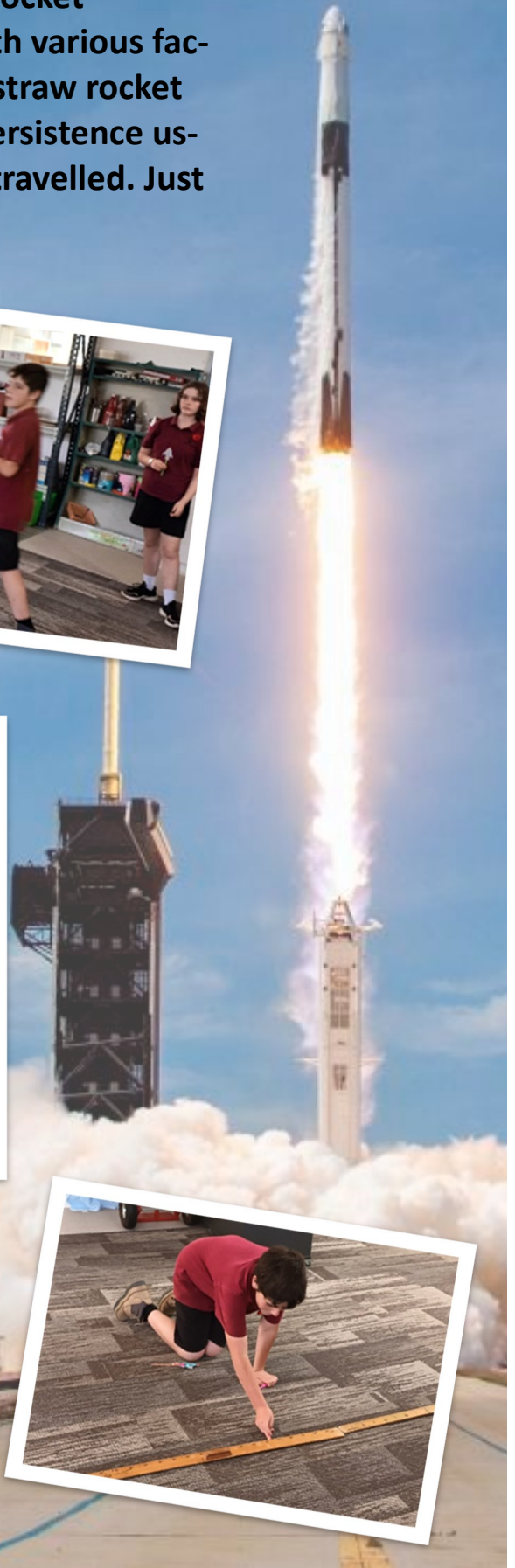
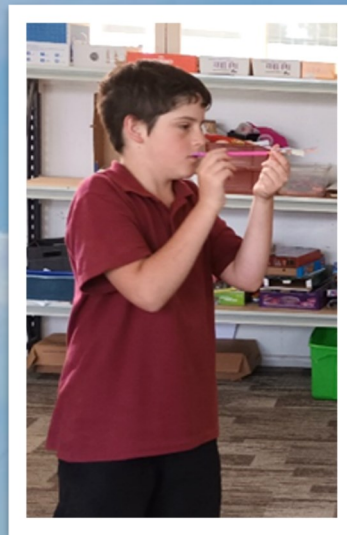
STEM - STRAW ROCKETS!
