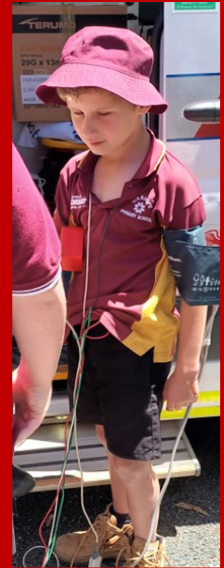

CPR



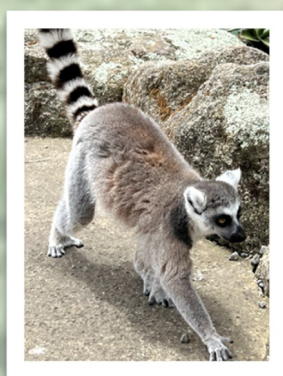



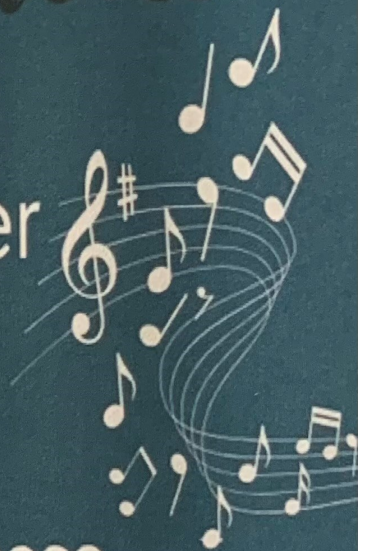
