## Student Assessments

As part of the formal testing for students, all Prep, One, and Two students are required to undergo the English Online Interview before the end of February and we have almost completed this assessment. Naplan testing for grades 3 and 5 students, has moved to March this year where previously it was always held in May.

We plan to have parent-student-teacher conversations either towards the end of this term or early in Term 2.

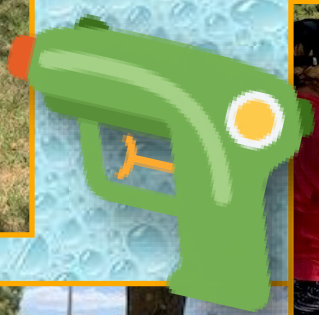




# WATER FUN


