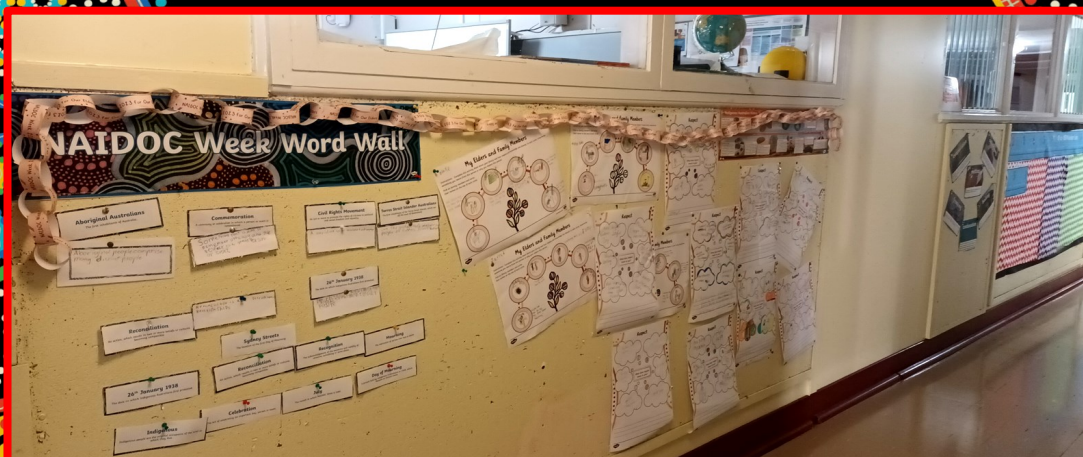
# FOR OUR ELDERS NAIDOC WEEK

They completed an image map showing how that knowledge and respect were demonstrated and passed on from elders in their own families.

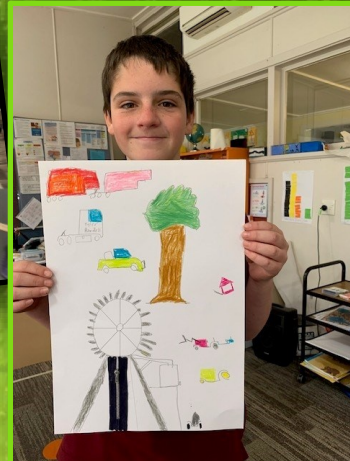
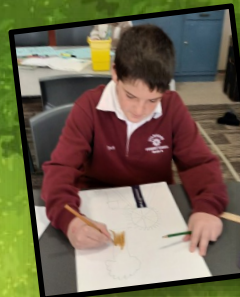
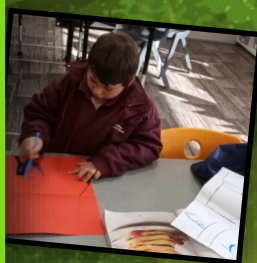
Our students completed posters describing what 'respect' meant to them, how it felt and sounded, and what it looked like.





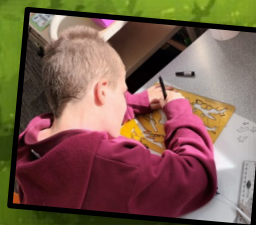
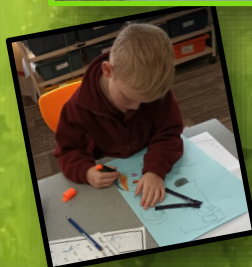
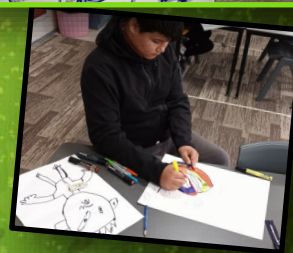
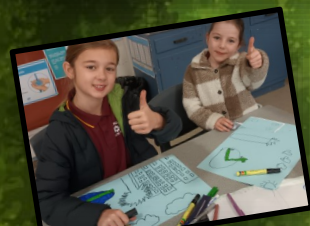
