This has been a great start, but being prepared for summer and living around waterways, it will be important that all students continue on with some lessons outside of school.

Wind Down

As we head towards the end of term 3, there are a few things to keep in mind and prepare for. Please remind students to collect their clothing items from the lost property pegs. Make sure your child's clothing is clearly named to avoid confusion. We also are in 'Hats On' season. Hats can be purchased from the school for \$5.00 each. Hats should be maroon and either be bucket style or a broad brimmed style that shades face and neck. Some students will be bringing home completed work books. Take the time to go through them and ask what some of the pages and work was about. What did your child learn? What do they still need help with? Conversations about learning are an important way to measure how your child feels about school.

Coming Up in Term 4

Our final term for the year is another busy one! We will have a date for the 'Power of Ducks Production and resume rehearsals. For grade 4-6 students there is the Urban Camp held in later November. Speak to Mica if you want to set up a payment plan for the cost of this camp. Unfortunately, we are unable to send students whose camp fees are not paid prior to the camp as we have to pay Urban Camp before students attend. Details and further information will be sent out soon as to what to pack etc. During the Urban Camp, we plan to hold an after-school picnic and movie session for those students who won't be on camp. More information will be given closer to the time. Throughout Term 4, the kinder and our school will be sharing some transition activities and visiting each other. As well, we will be joining with the kinder to practice for a combined presentation at the Stanhope Community Carols, in December. Eat Well Program. Our school is being supported to promote a healthy approach to food by Ky Health next term. A quick perusal of kids lunches and snacks reveals that most lunches are based on convenience and ease of preparation, rather than on nutrition. The Eat Well Program will show kids how to 'eat well' without it being too hard.
